

Public Access to Federal Advisory Committee Management Data:

FACA Database Public Access Manual.

What is the FACADatabase?

The FACA database is a specialized, Federal Government, interagency, information-sharing, data driven web application. The implementation of the **Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA)** originally required that, in addition to the specific procedures which federal advisory committees in the agencies must follow, specific data items about advisory committees be collected by the President annually and transmitted formally to Congress for review. The data collection, summarization, analysis, and transmission was completed within a calendar year framework in the seventies. When Congress changed government budget management to a Fiscal Year (FY) time frame, 10/1/---- through 9/30/----, data collection shifted to the first quarter of the new FY, 10/1/---- through 12/31/----, and the report was issued as soon as it could be prepared. This paper based data collection, collation, summarization, and publication continued, with minor changes in data items, content, and presentation, for 26 years, from 1972 through 1998. The process began each FY with the more than 1000 committees throughout the government submitting reports on approved forms and in a common format to their agencies, with some of the reports hundreds of pages long due to the number of members and meetings. The agencies duplicated the reports as required, totaled the numeric data, and sent sets of duplicates and totals to the Committee Management Secretariat (CMS) at the General Services Administration (GSA). The Secretariat spent much of the next year combining the committee reports, arranged by agency, into multiple loose-leaf binder sets for shipment to the Library of Congress and for internal reference, while simultaneously summarizing and analyzing the numeric data by agency and government wide totals. A printed summary report was transmitted annually to Congress over the President's signature.

In 1997 a web-based database, found at <http://facadatabase1997-2013.faca.gov/>, was developed to collect and report that data. In 1999, Congress required the implementation of the "Report Reduction Act" passed in 1995, which ended "the printed and transmitted hard-copy annual report." However, the same data has continued to be collected to comply with the Annual Comprehensive Review (ACR) requirement of FACA. This online, publicly accessible, data-collection and management application has been used by Congress, the President, federal agencies, the Committee Management Secretariat, and the public to have complete, real time access to Federal Advisory Committee data via the Internet in a read-only mode, from 1997 through the present. In 2013, a revised and updated version of the FACADatabase, found at <http://facadatabase.gov/> replaced the original system for use by the FACA community.

FACA continues to require that the agencies, through their Committee Management Officers (CMOs), provide information about the agency's advisory committees for the ACR. The FACADatabase accommodates and builds upon that requirement by allowing the continual updating of committee information throughout the reporting year and providing ongoing committee-management functionality. When the FACA community began keeping the data continuously up-to-date, the community converted the system and the process of record keeping from a focus on history and reporting, to a focus on management and immediate relevancy. With timely updates, the system became more useful to everyone. Users ranged from the public interested in a specific issue, to the agency official wanting an overview of specific committee activity, to the agency manager who wanted a broader view of committee activity across the agency, to researchers at the Library of Congress, to congressional or executive branch staff with oversight responsibility.

What kind of data has been collected?

- At the committee level, the program collects and displays
- Charters and related information,
 - Members and their appointment information,
 - Costs,
 - The agency's recommendation for continuation or termination of the committee,
 - The number of the committee's recommendations to the agency and the action taken on the recommendations,
 - Report titles, publication dates, and the text of the report if uploaded to the system,

- Meeting purposes, dates, location, whether the meetings were open or closed, and the minutes or transcript if uploaded to the system,
- Activity and justification (raison d'être) committee information,
- DFO appointment and contact information,
- Committee Decision Maker contact information,
- Web site addresses for the committee, or for accessing committee information like the minutes, reports, and recommendations,
- Committee interest or issue areas, and
- The history data available for the committee and its subcommittees since 1997.

This information exists for each committee and is aggregated by the agency as well as by the whole government, by year. The database does not require meeting announcements, although proposed future meetings can be listed. Some of the agencies and committees upload their meeting minutes and/or reports to this system. Some of the committees also put their meeting minutes, transcripts, meeting content information, reports, and recommendations to the agency on their committee web site or the agency web site. While the law and associated regulation requires that the minutes and reports be maintained in a central and accessible location, during the active life of the committee, the law and associated regulation do not yet require that the minutes and reports be uploaded to this system.

At the agency level, the program collects, totals, accesses, and/or displays all the information available mentioned above by committee. The program also collects, totals, accesses, and displays information that includes

- A current year list of agency advisory committees and the committees' update status,
- An agency totals report of the distribution among committees of establishment authorities and committee functions, and the total meetings, reports, costs, and members,
- A listing of committee DFOs with their contact information, and
- A complete set of the committee reports for all the committees in the agency,

Most of the meetings and work of federal advisory committees are considered public information, and all the data stored in the system except for committee members e-mail addresses and zip codes are available for downloading and viewing.

How does a member of the public use the system?

The FACA states that each agency shall establish uniform administrative guidelines and management controls for advisory committees created by that agency, and that each agency shall maintain systematic information on the nature, functions, and operations of each advisory committee within its jurisdiction. The law directs that the head of each agency that has an advisory committee shall designate an Advisory Committee Management Officer (CMO) who shall –

- Exercise control and supervision over the establishment, procedures, and accomplishments of advisory committees established by that agency;
- Assemble and maintain the reports, records, and other papers of any such committee during its existence; and
- Carry out, on behalf of that agency, the provisions of section 552 of title 5, United States Code, with respect to such reports, records, and other papers.

The law also states that

- There shall be designated an officer or employee of the Federal Government to chair or attend each meeting of each advisory committee. The officer or employee so designated is authorized, whenever he determines it to be in the public interest, to adjourn any such meeting. No advisory committee shall conduct any meeting in the absence of that officer or employee.
- Advisory committees shall not hold any meetings except at the call of, or with the advance approval of, a designated officer or employee of the Federal Government, and in the case of advisory committees (other than Presidential advisory committees), with an agenda approved by such officer or employee.

The FACA database system is designed to support those requirements by capturing relevant information when the committee is created online by the CMO, and to carry that information forward as it is edited and updated by the DFO or her designee from year to year until the information is no longer required. When a committee is first established and chartered by an agency, the information on the committee is entered by the CMO or his designee and addresses most of the committee's general information, membership information, and estimated cost information requirements under the law. Normally, when the agency CMO adds a committee to the system, the DFO is already officially appointed, and involved in the committee's mission and charter. The process is ordinarily expected to proceed as follows:

- The President, Congress, or a federal official in an agency decides that advice on an issue is needed and that an advisory committee is the appropriate vehicle for getting that advice,
- In the case of the President, he or she executes an executive order.
- In the case of the Congress, the congress passes a law that includes language assigning the responsibility for the committee to an agency.
- In the case of an agency, the agency, given it has the means and latitude; simply starts the process of developing a charter.
- The agency uses the administrative guidelines and management controls it established under FACA to
 - appoint a CMO for the agency,
 - develop the charter,
 - secure members,
 - appoint the DFO for the committee being established, and
 - delegate or assign the other responsibilities established under the law.
- The CMO
 - confers with the Committee Management Secretariat (CMS) regarding the new committee,
 - ensures that a DFO has been appointed,
 - creates the new committee online using the system,
 - files the charter with the appropriate congressional oversight committees and the Library of Congress, and
 - provides the appointed DFO and her designees with logons to the system.

When notified that she has been given a logon, the DFO logs onto the system and

- Edits all of the information entered by the CMO for completeness and accuracy. Most DFOs confer with the agency CMO before changing data entered by another user, but any user given edit rights by a CMO to a committee's data can make the changes they deem necessary. Multiple users can change data in the same committee at the same time. The last data saved wins.
- Adds meetings and reports as they are scheduled or occur,
- Adds or deletes members as they are appointed or replaced,
- Adds or updates costs as they occur,
- Adds, updates, changes, or clarifies the justifications, activities, and committee recommendations to the agency if the situation warrants,
- Adds or updates the web addresses if a web site is created for the committee or committee information is available at other web sites,
- Adds or updates the committee performance measures,
- Adds or updates contact information as it changes.


At the end of the fiscal year, the DFO, in consultation with the CMO

- recommends the continuance or termination of the committee, and
- verifies the accuracy and completeness of the committee data for the closing year.

Then, at the beginning of each new fiscal year, the system carries all of the data entered for the previous year forward for the year, except for costs, meetings, reports, and members whose appointments have ended. Terminated committees are dropped from the agency's committee list in the fiscal year following their termination, but their history and information will continue to be accessible and displayed under various history links.

Finding and Using the System

The opening screen for the **FACA Database** lists users' options. The address for the system is www.facadatabase.gov. **Buttons** and **Hyperlinks** control navigation throughout the system. The **hyperlinks** that are visible change depending upon the purpose of the page and the access rights of the user. The hyperlinks are located in the top border area. Users should move from page to page with the links in the program as much as possible and avoid use of the browser buttons (like the “**arrows**”) to go back or forward unless directed to do so on the web page they are viewing, or the web application is displaying a report.




The **FACA Database** is an online application. A database and online application operate differently than purely informational Internet pages. Browser buttons are designed to take the user backwards and forwards to pages of what may be static, unchanging, and perhaps unrelated content. The pages of a data driven application change in content with every selection and filter, but have a distinct relationship with the preceding and following pages as the user drills down or moves back up through the data. The user is involved in an online research session viewing specific, but related content in a specific context. If the user navigates using the browser menu, the application's organizing principle can be thwarted. The underlying data tables are “connected” by “key” fields and the connection can be “dropped” or lost. This happens rarely and the technology is continuously improving to prevent this conundrum, but a word to the wise. If this should appear to have happened or be suspected, the Public Access user can always click **HOME**, which resets the “keys,” and begin anew.

The 18 hyperlinks on the opening screen link to **Log In**, **Home**, **Agencies**, **Search**, **ACR Files**, **Datasets**, **Help**, **FAQ**, the **Committee Management Secretariat Website** on the GSA Portal, **Common Questions about Federal Advisory Committees** on the GSA Portal, **The Annual Report of the President on Federal Advisory Committees – 1972-1998** list, the **Case Digest Search** online database, the archive **FACA Database (Version 1 - 1997 - 2012)**, **GSA**: the GSA agency portal, **DataCall Systems** is the development contractor's website, **Support Team Members**, and **Security and Privacy Notice**.


The **Log In** link is for users who are responsible for advisory committee management, and managing and updating the committee data. Users with committee management responsibilities can manage their individual committees as well as edit and update their committee's data, users with agency management responsibilities can manage, edit, and update all of their agency's committees, and the Committee Management Secretariat's staff can manage, edit, and update all the agencies' data.



Home returns the user to the opening screen of the module they are logged into and using. For the Public Access user, **Home** always returns the user to the first screen they viewed on the website, which is displayed to the right.



Agencies links to a list of agencies which currently have advisory committees.



The agency list can change from year to year, because not every agency has an advisory committee every year. The user can select the agency with the committees in which they have an interest. The Agencies screen is discussed in more detail later in this manual.

The **Search** link allows the user to Search for data in multiple ways: **Search for Committee by Name or Number** requires the Advisory Committee ID number or part of the Committee name, and the selection of the **Current** year or **History**; **Search for Committee by Interest Area** requires selecting a topic of interest to the committee; **Search FACA Documents** allows a text search of all the documents uploaded to the database system; **Database Search** provides a query tool for committee data; **Members Search** provides a query tool for member data; **Case Digest Search** searches FACA Case Law; or use the **USA.Gov Search** engine. The search features are described in more detail later in the manual.



ACR Files lists the sets of reports prepared each year at the end of the Annual Comprehensive Review conducted by the Secretariat each fiscal year. These reports are consistent with the committee data reports which were prepared for inclusion in the Annual Report of the President to Congress on Federal Advisory Committees which was produced from 1972 through 1998, and are provided to allow historical comparisons.

The Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA) database is used by Federal agencies to continuously manage an average of 1,000 advisory committee government-wide. This database is also used by the Congress to perform oversight of related Executive Branch programs, and refers to any stream of approved developments resulting from advisory committee activities. Although centrally supported by the General Services Administration's Committee Management Secretariat, the database represents a true "shared system" where agency and individual committee managers has responsibility for providing accurate and timely information that may be used to assure that the system's wide array of users has access to data required by FACA.

 These are common words such as: a, an, and, as and others. These words will be ignored by the search engine unless they are part of a Boolean (see below) search.
Punctuation marks:
 Punctuation marks such as: ; (semicolon), : (colon), . (full stop/period), , (comma) and others are ignored by the search engine.
Special Characters:
 To use specially treated characters such as \$, |, ^, #, @, \$, (,), in a query, enclose your query in quotation marks ("").

Search Help:
Cases:
 The search engine is case insensitive so the query "User Manual" will return the same results as "user manual".
Keyword Search:
 The query, user manual will return all documents containing the words "user" and "manual". This type of search will return the same results as the Boolean "user" AND "manual".
Phrase Search:
 The query, "user manual" which will only return documents containing "user manual".
Boolean Searches:
 The query, user AND NOT manual will return documents containing "user" but not "manual".
 The query, user AND manual will return documents containing the words "user" and "manual".
 The query, user OR manual will return documents containing "user" and also documents containing "manual".
Proximity Searches:
 The query, user NEAR manual will return documents containing the word "user" NEAR the word "manual".
Advanced Searches:
 The query @size > 1000 will return all documents with a size greater than 1KB.
 The query #filename *.doc will return only word documents.
 The query @write > 01/2/1 10:00:00 will return only documents modified since the 1st Feb 2001 at 12:00am.
 The query man" will return all documents containing "man" as part of a word, i.e. "manual", "manually" and so on.

The Database Search

The **Database Search** link displays the **Database Search** page. The FACADatabase is a live, working tool for the Advisory Committee community, and the data is stored in two separate sets of tables. One set is devoted to the current fiscal year where data is changed and updated, and one set is devoted to all the completed historical years where the data has been checked and verified and can no longer be changed. A user must decide which set of data they wish to search.



The user can select from the different categories of information to fine-tune a search. Pull down menus have been provided and the user can combine any of the categories. It is possible to select and combine criteria that result in no records being found, especially since data from the current year is often not completed until the federal users are urged to bring everything up to date for the ACR.

The **Database Search** does allow the user to pose a query to the database and get the response back as a report that can be saved in different formats.

A possible inquiry as shown by the example selections made in the form to the right could be articulated as “Give me all the committees current active that are **chartered**, **recommended to continue**, and **spending money** but had **no meetings** and **no reports** listed.” The report is on the next page.

The user can decide to save the search result as a spreadsheet file, an XML file (useful if you want to load the data into a database), or an ASCII file (a text file that can be used in any word processor). The query criteria are displayed in the search code used in the database in case the user wants to check whether the logic reflects their intention and they wish refine the query further.

The Members Search

Since there are more than 65,000 citizens contributing their time to advisory committee concerns in any given year, the system would be incomplete without a Member Search capability. There are limitations to our member data, however, and most of those limitations are self-imposed. This is a publicly accessible database and the database contains no more private, personal information than the minimum that FACA requires. The citizens contributing their time improve the effective functioning of the federal government are identified by name and occupation or affiliation.

Members Characteristics Search

The **Members Characteristics Search** page allows searching the current Member table or the Member history table by any or all of the listed characteristics. Searching all agencies for members with a last name like Fussell (not an overly common name) produces the page below. Since data is collected by Fiscal Year, and members serve for multiple years, a search like this one which involved more than one year would produce some duplication.

When using this feature, it is useful to remember that some groups and some agencies are very large. The Department of Health and Human Services [HHS] would have a list more than 30,000 members long during any single year. Downloading a report of that length is likely to hang up, so retrieving a dataset for the year is more efficient.

Charters and Other Docs

When an advisory committee is chartered by filing the Federal Advisory Committee Act compliant charter with the agency's congressional oversight committees, a copy of the charter is provided to the Secretariat by uploading an electronic final copy to this on-line database, which is considered to be the official repository for the Committee Management Secretariat. The charter is also sent to the Library Of Congress, as the legislation has required since it was passed in 1972. Some agencies maintain a very complete record of a committee's re-chartering and filing history by uploading internal and external process documents associated with the chartering process and the committee's Membership Balance Plan. All uploaded documents can be retrieved and reviewed or downloaded.

All Board members and ad hoc consultants serve without compensation. The Defense Science Board possesses 35 members and 9 Senior Fellows, as well as approximately 65 ad hoc consultants. The cost of acquiring and paying for the services of individuals possessing their level of expertise would total approximately \$1.5 - \$2 million per year. The savings arising from using volunteers pales in comparison to the improved performance DOD experiences from implementing recommendations made by the Board. Some performance improvements achieve cost savings and some achieve cost avoidance. At other times, recommendations may call for obtaining new capability to counter new threats. The total savings is impossible to determine due to the complex mix of savings, avoidance and increased capability.
